IT IS ORDERED:


Within 10 days after you receive this writ, you:

- •remove the defendant and all other persons found upon the premises claiming under the defendant, using such reasonable force as is necessary.
- remove or supervise removal of all personal property found in the premises not the property of the plaintiff, using such reasonable force as is necessary, unless the plaintiff or his or her agent notifies you that the plaintiff or his or her agent will remove and store or dispose of the personal property.
- exercise ordinary care in the removal or supervision of removal of all persons from the premises, in the removal or supervision of removal of personal property, and in the handling and storage of all property removed from the premises.
- store and dispose of any removed personal property according to law unless the plaintiff or his or her agent notifies you that the plaintiff or the plaintiff's agent will remove and store or dispose of the personal property found in the premises.
- complete the Sheriff's Report on page 2 and return this Writ to the court.
